



Cedar County Board Minutes



December 28, 2021

The Cedar County Commissioners met in the Boardroom of the Cedar County Courthouse at 8:30 am and the meeting was called to order as advertised, with Craig Bartels, David McGregor and Chris Tramp answering roll call. Also, present County Clerk David Dowling. Chairman McGregor stated the open meetings laws are posted on the wall for public inspection.

Motion was made by Tramp and seconded by Bartels to approve the agenda. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Motion was made by Bartels and seconded by Tramp to approve the minutes from the last meeting. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Motion was made by Bartels to allow District Two road department lease a CAT Model 150-15 rear wheel drive motor grader and the motion was seconded by McGregor. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Road Supt., Carla Schmidt presented fracture critical bridge inspections by district were presented to each commissioner. Carla stated there are 21 in the whole county, not all of them have a maintenance issue.

Motion by Bartels and seconded by Tramp to approve and sign tax corrections on parcels 7572,7570 and 7565.01 and the motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Motion was made by Bartels and seconded by Tramp to approve the request to move 2 acres parcel number 3885.01 into the Randolph Fire District from the Belden Fire District. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Motion was then made by Bartels and seconded by McGregor to approve resolution 23-16 term 2023 salaries. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote.

Zoning Administrator, Tim Gobel presented a conditional use permit for Mitchell Sudbeck and a motion was made by McGregor and seconded by Bartels to approve the conditional use permit for Michell Sudbeck. Motion carried with a 3 to 0 vote. Tim then presented a building permit issued to Ted Thelen for 2500 square foot house and also presented a complete list of all building permits and conditional use permits.

Janet Wiechelman, Clerk of District Court asked the board to meet with her upstairs to discuss making changes to the courtroom for the addition of video equipment for court use in future hearings and cases.

With no further business or agenda items the meeting was declared adjourned.
